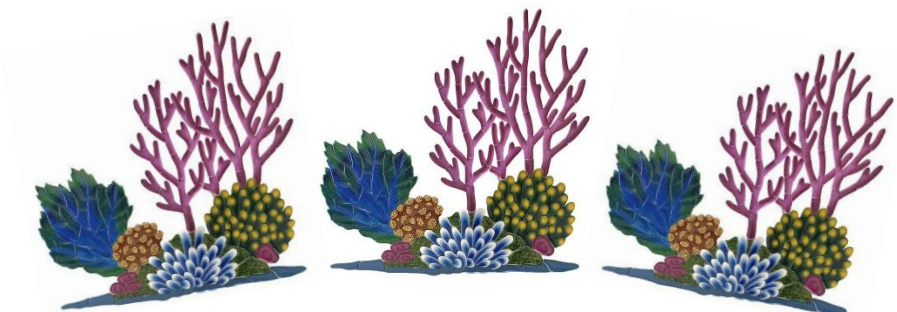


In many islands in the park, there are a lot of steep limestone and beaches. Many people in the past said that Ko Phetra looked a lot like a barque.

Lidi island is one of the islands of Mu Ko Phetra National Park. The name Lidi derived from Malay language means “a stick”.



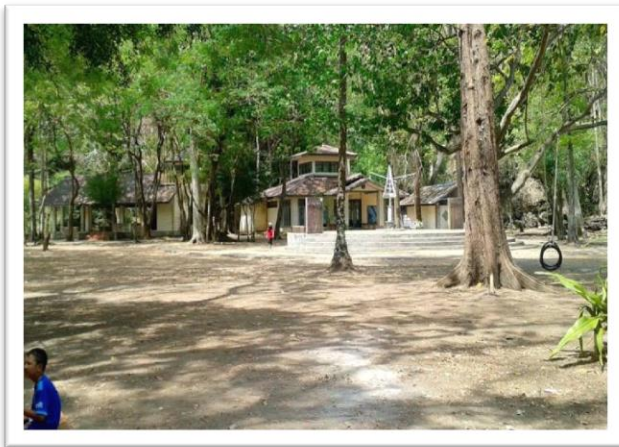

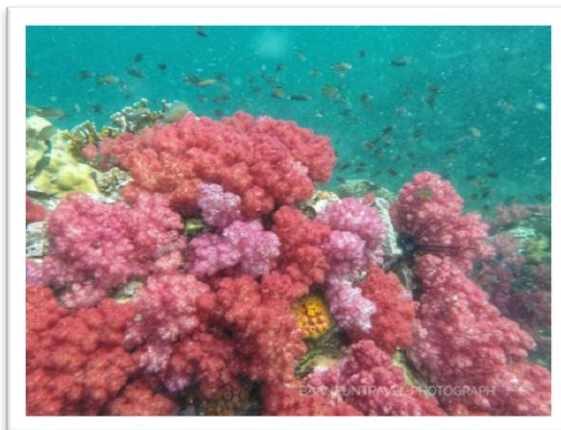
Bulone island is called the pearl of Andaman. It is 22 kilometers far from the Pak Bara seaport.

Mr.Chaiwat Saiyakul founded The La-ngu Local Museum. It is located opposite Wat Athon Rangsarit on the La-ngu – Chalung Road. He has a big passion on collecting antiques. He started to collect antiques since 1985. He decided to open an antique museum and display them in 1988. The antique displays are on the second floor of the museum. There are ancient, remains, artifacts, silverwares,



kitchenwares, banknotes, coins and etc. The outstanding antique is the 3-eared pot which is more than 4,000 years old.

On the ground floor, there are souvenirs and desserts of La-ngu district for sale.

Bo Chet Luk is one of the historic sites located at Pak Nam sub-district. It has a long legend. Long time ago, a group of fishermen moved from their own place. They came to this place to find pure water to drink, but they couldn't find any. They decided to dig a large pond. There was no pure water. The only kind of water they found was



brackish water. They didn't give up. They just kept digging. Finally, when they dug the seventh pond, they found the pure water. Those seven ponds are now at Ban Bo Chet Luk as the evidence. Chet in Thai means seven so that the name Bo Chet Luk means seven ponds. That is the reason why they named this village like this.

1. วางไว้หน้า คำนาม ที่มันจะไปขยาย
2. วางไว้หลัง Verb to be (be, is, am, was, were, been) หรือ หลังกริยาพิเศษบางตัว เช่น seem ดูเหมือน, taste มีรสชาติ, sound ฟังดู, feel รู้สึก

➡ ตัวอย่าง

- Daniel is a **perfect** guy. = แดเนียลเป็นผู้ชายที่สมบูรณ์แบบ
- This is **my** friend. = นี่คือเพื่อนของฉัน
- I am the **first** child of my family. = ฉันเป็นลูกคนแรกของครอบครัว
- Emma wants to buy **two** pens. = เอ็มมาต้องการจะซื้อปากกา 2 ด้าม
