
ข่าว (News) หมายถึง เหตุการณ์ที่คนในสังคมกำลังให้ความสนใจและตีพิมพ์ เผยแพร่ทางหนังสือพิมพ์ หรือนิตยสาร เหตุการณ์ที่นำมาเขียนเป็นข่าวจะต้องเป็น เรื่องทันเหตุการณ์หรือส่งผลกระทบต่อบุคคลในสังคม

องค์ประกอบของข่าวมี 3 ส่วน คือ

1. **Headline** (หัวข้อข่าว/พาดหัวข่าว) ให้ข้อมูลแก่ผู้อ่านถึงแนวคิดข่าว เกี่ยวกับเรื่องอะไร โดยชี้ให้เห็นความสำคัญของเรื่อง
2. **Lead** (พาดหัวรอง) ย่อหน้าแรกของข่าวจะบอกความสำคัญของ ข้อเท็จจริงในข่าวหรือใจความสำคัญ ขยายความหัวข้อเด่นและให้ข้อมูลเพิ่มเติมอีก เล็กน้อยเพื่อนำผู้อ่านเข้าสู่เนื้อข่าว
3. **Body** (เนื้อข่าว) บอกรายละเอียดของข่าวอย่างละเอียดว่าใคร ทำอะไร ที่ไหน เมื่อไร อย่างไร
