


Figure 2: The map of each country in ASEAN




Figure 3: The flag of each country in ASEAN




Figure 4: The map of mainland and maritime Southeast Asia Countries





Figure 5: Compass

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



Exercise 15

Cambodia and the Philippines

There are similarities and differences between Cambodia and the Philippines. Both Cambodia and the Philippines are located in Southeast Asia. Cambodia is located in mainland Southeast Asia, but the Philippines is located in maritime Southeast Asia. They are also different in the countries they border. Cambodia borders Thailand in the west, Laos in the north, Vietnam in the east, and the Gulf of Thailand in the south, whereas the Philippines borders the South China Sea in the west and the Philippine Sea in the east. Both Cambodia and the Philippines are in the same region, but the countries they border are different.
